**Minutes of the monthly review meeting of the District Development Committee (DDC), Darrang for review of progress report of the ongoing schemes and programmes under all the Departments of Darrang district.**

The District Development Committee (DDC) meeting held today on the 21<sup>st</sup> of January, 2022, with an aim to review the progress of ongoing schemes and programmes of the different departments and to resolve inter-departmental issues. The meeting is chaired by the Deputy Commissioner, Darrang. At the very onset the Deputy Commissioner, Darrang, welcomed all the members present in the meeting and initiated the meeting with the discussion on the action points of the last DDC meeting held on the 18<sup>th</sup> of December, 2021. The following points were discussed and decisions taken in the meeting:

1.	Health	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The DIO was directed to increase the CVCs (Covid Vaccination Centers) upto at least 150-160 numbers so as to achieve the target for 2nd dose vaccination before the set deadline by the Govt. i.e 15<sup>th</sup> of February, 2022.</li><li>2. ADC vaccination to gear up the vaccination drive via phone calls and SMS immediately to aware public about the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose due.</li></ol>
2.	Education	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. In view of the present COVID-19 scenario, IS &amp; DEEO, Darrang, is directed to follow appropriate covid protocol in schools like wearing masks, etc. Schools with multiple covid cases to be immediately closed.</li><li>2. It has come to notice that the attendance of teachers in many schools are not satisfactory. On this note IS &amp; DEEO is instructed to strictly monitor the attendance of teachers and give show cause notice to the concerned person.</li><li>3. The issue of increasing numbers of dropped out students is also highlighted and IS&amp;DEEO is advised to create awareness campaign to prevent school dropout.</li></ol>
3.	Industry	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The GM DICCC, Darrang informed that bamboo, mustard, urahi, organic tea and lemon are exported from the district. He is directed to boost up export items and for this he will entitle one Assistant Manager at the help desk cell.</li><li>2. The Assistant Manager will contact the local SHGs of ASRLM and NULM and guide them how to increase the production and export their products. Proper awareness to be</li></ol>

		<p>generated among the locals in this field by the Industry Department</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>As informed by DFO, NK division, no proper license and registration found for stone crusher industries and brick industries, for which the District Mineral Foundation (DMF) Funds are going down. The DDC is directed to conduct a joint departmental inquiry into the matter so that proper issuance of license and registration done by the concerned departments.</li> <li>As informed by EO, MMB, space for City Livelihood Centre in a govt. Building is required to promote and display the products of SHGs under NULM. The GM, DICG is directed to provide the same for SHGs of both ASRLM and NULM.</li> </ol>
4.	Water Resource	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Executive Engineer WR Department informed that out of 224 kms embankment in the district, most of them are illegally encroached, blocking the natural water flow as a result of which flooding issue arises during the monsoon season. All the Circle Officers are directed to evict the unauthorized settlers from the embankment areas. Also EE requested Circle Officers to demarcate the boundary of embankments.</li> <li>Administrative Approval (AA) for the Embankment to be built by Water Resource Department behind Cancer Hospital not yet received. The EE will forward a letter, through DC Darrang, to the concerned Head of the Department of Govt. of Assam.</li> </ol>
5.	PHE	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Executive Engineer, PHE informed that 127 new schemes awarded to the district. The EE is directed to give necessary instructions to the contractors to complete the schemes within the given time limit.</li> <li>On the issue of water supply and its maintenance at Mangaldai Civil Hospital campus, the Hospital Authority is directed to contact with PHE department so that additional schemes can be prepared.</li> <li>The IS&amp;DEEO is directed to cooperate with EE PHE to resolve a minor technical issue of water supply at Ganesh Kuwori HS School.</li> <li>For sanitization in the Municipal area, PHE Mangaldai Division is directed to provide the key material (sodium hypochlorite) to both the MBs.</li> </ol>
6.	Transport	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The DTO, Darrang informed that 55% of revenue collected which is approx. 11 crore out of the target of 24 crore till date. He also informed that strict enforcement drive against drunk drive, non-wearing of helmets for both rider and pillion rider is going on in the district. Overall accident cases decreasing in the last few days.</li> <li>The Chair expressed dissatisfaction regarding revenue collection and directed the DTO to achieve 100% revenue target in the time bound period. Strict enforcement against drunk drive and non-wearing of helmets to be continued and also fines to be duly collected.</li> <li>Regarding the use of speed gun in the interceptor, the DTO informed that speed radar gun has been installed to check rash driving in the district but till now they haven't got the</li> </ol>

		<p>permission to use it. The DTO is directed to take up the matter with Head Office, Govt. Assam.</p> <p>4. Department to ensure that trucks carrying sand, stone and earth to be covered properly while on the roads.</p>
7.	National Highway	<p>1. The Chair directed the Executive Engineer, NH Rangia division to install road safety reflectors properly on the highway for smooth mobility of the vehicles</p> <p>2. Circle Officer Mangaldai Revenue Circle will report on the availability of govt. land for earth cutting for the construction of NH by pass</p>
8.	APDCL	<p>1. The AGM, APDCL raised the issue of pending electricity bills from the Gaon Panchayat Offices and Schools. The concerned departments were directed to act immediately on this matter. Also, APDCL to provide specific monthly bills to the departments.</p> <p>2. Regarding the electrical connection in the Cancer Hospital, the hospital authority to contact with APDCL and Electrical Inspector's office, Tezpur immediately.</p>
9.	Labour	<p>1. The Labour Officer, Darrang informed that</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 2,34,878 no.s of unorganized workers have been registered under e-shram portal.</li> <li>- 1057 no's of labourers have registered under PM-SYM (Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maan Dhan).</li> </ul> <p>The Labour Officer is directed to create awareness regarding PM-SYM and to consult the matter with CEO Zila Parishad for enrolling the name of job card holders under the scheme.</p> <p>2. The Labour Officer, Darrang also informed that three child labours have been rescued in the month of December.</p> <p>3. The IS &amp; DEEO to follow up the proposal send to Govt. of Assam for 7 new seasonal education centers for migratory children near brick-kilns.</p>
10.	Veterinary	<p>1. The DVO, darrang informed that cattle tagging is going on in the district and the work of Sipajhar Duck farm have been completed.</p>
11.	Handloom & Textile	<p>1. The Assistant Director H &amp; T, Darrang informed that during this financial year 06 no.s of Mudra Loans have been sanctioned out of 229 no.s of applicants.</p> <p>2. Regarding yarn bank he informed that they are selling yarn to the beneficiaries at 50% subsidiary rate.</p>
12.	Sericulture	<p>1. The Assistant Director of sericulture informed that Muga Mission is going on but nursery fund has not yet being released by the Govt. The Chair to take up the matter with higher authority.</p> <p>2. The project at Gorukhuti will start shortly.</p>
13.	Town & Country planning	<p>1. The member present informed that under PMAY(U), 576 targets have been accomplished in Mangaldoi MB and the data of Kharupetia MB is yet to be updated. The EO, Mangaldai MB and EO, Kharupetia MB is directed to monitor the progress of PMAY (U).</p> <p>2. The T&amp;CP department is directed to complete the Master Plan</p>

		<p>for Mangaldai Municipal Area at the earliest. Also to Update about the Master Plan for Kharupetia Municipal Area undertaken by ASTEC.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Regarding the drainage master plan, T&amp;CP department will follow up the matter with Executive Engineer for conducting drainage survey in Mangaldai and Kharupetia Municipal area.</li> <li>Proposal for building Conference Hall near Treasury Office Darrang from the CIDF Fund, to be placed by T&amp;CP Department at DC Office Darrang for onward submission.</li> </ol>
14.	Fishery	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The District Fishery Development Officer informed that Group Accident Insurance scheme (GAIS) is being offered as a part of PMMSY for insurance coverage of fish workers, fish farmers, etc but enrollment under this scheme is less. He is directed to create awareness campaign in this regard.</li> </ol>
15.	Irrigation	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The EE Irrigation informed that 680 hectares of land will be irrigated under Kurua LIS scheme and 6.92 lakh amount have been sanctioned in this regard. The EE is directed to execute the scheme expeditiously.</li> <li>The EE, Irrigation also informed that under PMKVSy, 213 no's of tube wells have been distributed.</li> <li>The Mangaldai Division have been reorganized into three sub-divisions viz. Mangaldai, Sipajhar and Dalgaon.</li> <li>The data for Irrigation department to be uploaded on the Aspirational District portal along with the data of Agricultural department from the next month.</li> </ol>
16.	Agriculture	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The District Agriculture Officer, Darrang informed that total 1392.8 quintals of paddy were procured from Mangaldai paddy procurement centre till date.</li> <li>Total 1237 paddy procurement certificates issued.</li> <li>A total of 24000 new applications have been received under PMKISAN scheme.</li> </ol>
17.	Municipal Board	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The EO, Mangaldai Municipal Board is directed to take necessary steps for maintenance of parks in the Municipal area. A meeting to be convened with the stakeholders immediately.</li> <li>Cleanliness of the Municipal areas to be monitored regularly by the EO, Mangaldai Municipal Board and EO, Kharupetia Municipal Board.</li> </ol>
18.	PWD(road)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Under Assam Mala project construction of road from Sipajhar to Dalanghat and from Dalgaon to Dhupguri are going on. But due to land acquisition issue at Sipajhar the execution of the work is at a slow pace. A meeting to be convened with Circle Officers, ADC revenue, EE(PWD) (Roads) etc regarding this issue.</li> <li>As the Cancer Hospital will start functioning from April 2022, the approach road from NH15 to Cancer Hospital to be completed before April 2022 by PWRD Roads. EE, PWRD Roads informed that sanction for the road not yet received so DC Darrang will pursue the matter with Commissioner PWRD (Roads), Govt. of Assam.</li> <li>PWRD (Roads) will built speed-breakers on the roads connecting the National Highway. This is also included in the</li> </ol>

		monitorable targets for the Department.
19.	P&RD	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The CEO Zila Parishad raised the issue that around 7000 landless beneficiaries are not enrolled in PMAY-G due to non-availability of land. All the Circle Officers are directed to identify land on an immediate basis and place the proposals at the SDLAC meeting.</li> <li>2. Special ponds to be identified by P&amp;RD for Jute Cultivation.</li> <li>3. DFO social forestry will assist P&amp;RD Department in raising nursery of Chandan and Agar and Sericulture Department will assist for raising the Som plants nursery at Pub-Mangaldai Development Block.</li> </ol>
20.	Social Forestry	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. For the development of Nagar Bhatika near Sipajhar and Mangaldai Town area, DFO Social Forestry will follow up the matter of land allocation with Circle Officers of Sipajhar Revenue Circle and Mangaldai Revenue Circle.</li> <li>2. PWD Building to coordinate with Social Forestry department to renovate the Park near Bhebarghat Bus stand.</li> </ol>
21.	Forest	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. DFO NK Division to prepare the proposal for Upgradation of 3 PRFs in the District.</li> <li>2. DFO NK Division will report the number of unregistered brick-kiln industries and similar industries in the district.</li> </ol>
22.	Banks	Delayed loan disbursal by the banks is the major issue raised by many departments. LDM is directed to look into the matter.
23.	Revenue	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Encroachment behind the Cancer Hospital and at the Solid Waste Management site of Mangaldai Municipal Board is seriously noted by the chair and directed the Circle Officer, Mangaldai Revenue Circle to evict the encroachers in the said sites and in and around Mangaldai Town area on an immediate basis.</li> <li>2. Circle Officer Dalgaon Revenue Circle is directed to evict the encroachers from the land of Industry department.</li> <li>3. Circle Officer Dalgaon Revenue Circle will shift the Swahid Bedi to an appropriate Place after consultation with the Public.</li> </ol>

- Circle Officers are directed to carry on eviction drive against all unauthorized structures as directed in the Meeting. Action Taken report to be submitted in the next DDC Meeting.
